H-1B PETITION CHECKLIST FOR SCHOLAR

TRAVEL ADVISORY: ISSO strongly discourages traveling abroad between the time the H-1B petition is submitted and the initial start date (or extension start date) listed on the H-1B petition. Under certain circumstances, traveling on another visa status or a previous H-1B record may jeopardize the approval of H-1B status, and/or require additional travel plans abroad to ensure a valid duration of H-1B status.
